The Department of Special Education, Foundations, and Research in the College of Education at East Carolina University is seeking applicants and nominations for a tenure-track, nine-month, full-time faculty position available August 15, 2018. Rank and salary: Commensurate with qualifications. Responsibilities include teaching undergraduate and/or graduate K-12 special education courses (i.e., adapted curriculum undergraduate, low-incidence disability graduate, and service classes offered to general education teacher candidates) on campus and/or online via distance education delivery; supervising practicum experiences and internships; engaging in an active research and publication agenda including grant writing; and providing service to the university, community, and profession.

Minimum Qualifications

(1) Must hold an earned doctorate degree in special education by August 15, 2018; (2) three years of teaching students receiving adapted curriculum in a K-12 setting; (3) documented experience in college teaching of face-to-face and/or on-line courses; and (4) eligibility for NC Teacher Licensure.

Preferred Qualifications and Experience

Special consideration will be given to applicants with expertise related to adapted curriculum populations: (1) transition for K-12, (2) post-secondary higher education opportunities, (3) general curriculum access, (4) collaborative work with public schools and/or (5) learners who are culturally and linguistically diverse.

Finalists will demonstrate teaching skills and present the results of a current research study, as well as plans for future research. If selected for employment, they will have the opportunity to work with the Associate Dean for Funded Research on submitting proposal for research start-up funds available at East Carolina University. Screening begins November 1, 2017 and continues until the position is filled. Official transcripts required prior to written contract offer.
