Length of Term: 2 years

Time Commitment: Average 2 hours a month. Depending on Board Meetings and Conferences can be a little less or a little more.

Description:

The TED Student Representative is a **2-year commitment** that would start in **January 2025** and end **December 2027**. Appointments are staggered so in any given year there is one new, junior representative and one veteran, senior representative. This allows for mentoring and continuity in Kaleidoscope goals. Benefits of being a TED Student Representative include but are not limited to the following opportunities: networking with other doctoral students and university staff, being mentored into a service position, and funding to support travel to the CEC and TED conference. The responsibilities of a TED Student Representative includes a set of manageable tasks shared with a fellow student representative.

The powers and duties of the Publications & Communications Member-at-Large shall be to:

- Chair the Kaleidoscope Doctoral Student Committee
- Facilitate Kaleidoscope programs at the CEC Annual Convention and Expo and the annual TED Conference, and
- Represent Kaleidoscope on the Executive Board
